### COURSE INFORMATION

#### COURSE OVERVIEW

The aim of the two-day program, presented by Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center staff and invited speakers, is to highlight developments in the clinical care of patients and provide useful insights into ongoing cancer research at the Center.

#### TARGET AUDIENCE

The intended audience is comprised of members of the Memorial Hospital Alumni Society (physicians who have trained at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center for six months or more and staff members who have been at MSKCC for six months or more), any current medical staff, and physicians trained elsewhere who wish to attend. These physicians include medical oncologists, pathologists, radiation oncologists, surgeons, and allied scientists.

#### EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The course objective is to advance and disseminate knowledge of cancer, with the sharing of objectives between community physicians and the Center. The goal is also to inform primary care clinicians about current approaches to the diagnosis and treatment of cancers.

#### COURSE DESIGN

This course is comprised of lectures and discussions, encouraging the exchange of ideas between faculty and participants.

#### ACCREDITATION

Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to sponsor continuing medical education for physicians.
