## Get To Know Me

I am a surgeon who cares for people with cancers of the [colon](#), [rectum](#), [anus](#), [appendix](#), and peritoneum.

I am experienced in the treatment of cancers within the peritoneal cavity (the space between the organs in the abdomen), such as pseudomyxoma peritonei and [mesothelioma](#). Additionally, I have specialized training in using state-of-the-art surgical approaches for [colorectal cancer](#), including laparoscopy and robotic surgery. These [minimally invasive](#) methods allow us to avoid colostomy while preserving bowel, bladder, and sexual function.

When patients first meet with me, they often are anxious about their diagnosis. Many have received information about their prognosis that can sometimes be quite different from our patients' outcomes. As a result, they have many questions about how their cancer and treatment will affect their quality of life and outlook.


