I am a medical oncologist who specializes in research in and treatment of patients with genitourinary cancers, including bladder, prostate, kidney, and testis cancers.

This provider is part of a team that was ranked <u>#1 in the nation for Urology Cancer Care</u> this year by U.S. News & World Report.

I also have a special interest in understanding the genetic basis for bladder cancer and am a member of Memorial Sloan Kettering's Bladder Cancer Oncogenome Project, a multidisciplinary effort to discover the key genetic abnormalities that drive this disease. The discovery and understanding of these genetic abnormalities hold the promise of novel treatments for patients with bladder cancer.

My Role at MSK

A genitourinary (jeh-nih-toh-YOOR-ih-nayr-ee) oncologist is a cancer doctor with special training in the genitourinary (GU) system. This includes bladder, kidney, penis, prostate, and testicular cancers.

An early drug development specialist tests new drugs to treat cancer. They have special training in research studies, known as clinical trials.


