It's important that they feel confident about their treatment plan and the devoted team of specialists at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center who will take care of them.

When patients first come to see me, they are often scared because they have been told they have a potentially life-threatening disease, or perhaps because they are afraid of being disfigured. Many newly diagnosed patients are also confused because there is so much information out there about breast cancer, some of which is incorrect, that it is hard for them to figure out what applies to them and what does not.
