Our targeted tumor sequencing test, [MSK-IMPACT™](#) (Integrated Mutation Profiling of Actionable Cancer Targets), was designed to detect gene mutations and other critical genetic aberrations in both rare and common cancers. Available exclusively to MSK patients, this test can provide results that help rule out treatment options that may be ineffective and potentially lead to new therapies targeting to genetic mutations.


