The Hematopathology Service at Memorial Sloan Kettering (MSK) is a high-volume clinical service with more than 30,000 hematological malignancy specimens and flow cytometry cases accessioned each year. The service utilizes an all-digital clinical workflow with integrated artificial intelligence tools, at the cutting edge of hematopathology practice. The fellow develops their diagnostic skills through exposure to a mix of in-house biopsies, surgical specimens, and extramural consultation cases. Excellent communication skills are built through consensus/interesting case meetings, tumor boards, journal clubs, and presentations at conferences.

Eighteen hematopathology faculty are enthusiastically engaged in teaching the fellows in all areas of hematopathology. Didactic lectures and microscope sessions are given by the faculty to the fellows throughout the year. Other academic activities are offered by both the Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine and the Hematology/Oncology Department. There are numerous research opportunities for fellows, and most fellows participate in at least one project resulting in research publications, as well as presentations at national and international meetings.

All applicants should be MDs or MD/PhDs who have completed residency training in AP, CP or AP/CP in the United States (ACGME accredited) or Canada and who are certified (or are eligible for certification) by the American Board of Pathology.

- Copy of a medical school diploma and translation, if necessary.
- International medical school graduates must submit a copy of their Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certificate that is marked “valid indefinitely”
