FOR THE MEDIA
As a member of the clinical team, the Brunschwig residents are involved with the care of Gynecology Service inpatients and outpatients. Residents may participate in outpatient office hours, assist with surgical procedures, and participate in preoperative and postoperative care of patients. By working closely with both the Radiation Oncology and Medical Oncology Services, the Brunschwig resident's experience will include an education set within a multidisciplinary setting. The gynecology fellow and attending surgeon always perform surgical procedures. The Brunschwig residents are expected to participate in the Gynecology Service's numerous weekly and monthly meetings.

The residents are on call approximately four to five times per month; they are off on post-call days.
