On June 17, Memorial Sloan Kettering's Junior Faculty Council presented its 2008 Award for Excellence in Mentoring to [Alan N. Houghton](#), Vice Chair for Academic Affairs in the Department of Medicine and incumbent of the Virginia and Daniel K. Ludwig Clinical Chair. The council cited Dr. Houghton as a role model and "a generous mentor who strives to have us all succeed."

A pioneer in cancer immunology, Dr. Houghton served as Chief of the Clinical Immunology Service in the Department of Medicine from 1989 to 2005 and was Chair of the [Immunology Program](#) in the [Sloan Kettering Institute](#) from 1995 to 2004. He joined the Center as a clinical fellow in 1977.
