Vincent du Vigneaud Symposium 2006

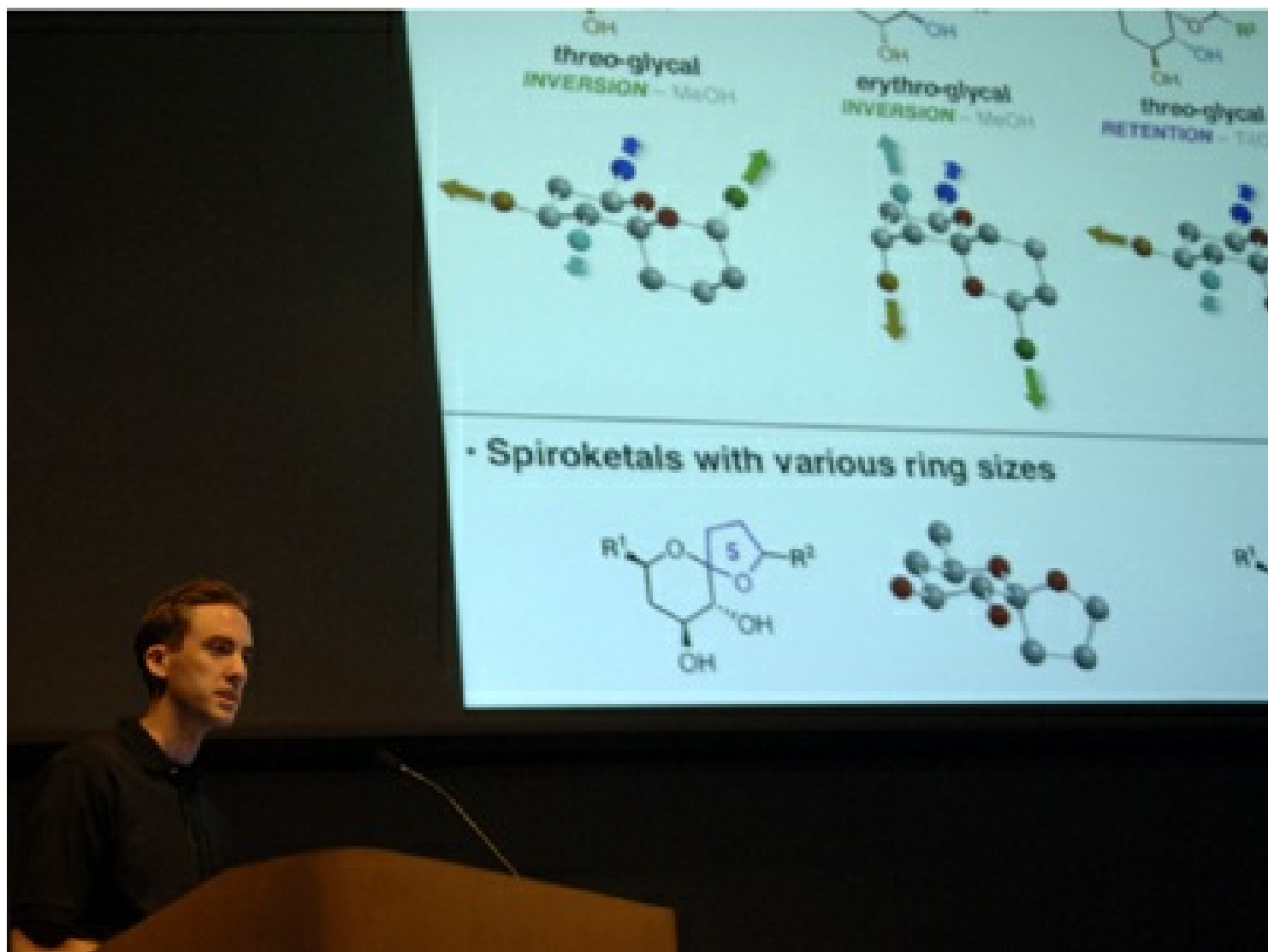

The du Vigneaud Symposium is an annual highlight, featuring posters and oral presentations by students in the [Chemistry Department](#). The symposium is named in honor of [Vincent du Vigneaud](#), who served as the department at Cornell Medical College from 1938-1967, and recipient of the [1955 Nobel Prize in Chemistry](#).
