At the Evelyn H. Lauder Breast Center, these specialists work as a team in caring for each patient, commonly consulting with one another since they are in such close physical proximity. Diana Mott, a registered nurse, emphasizes the convenience of a facility in which a mammogram can be done in the same building that treatment is provided, for example.
