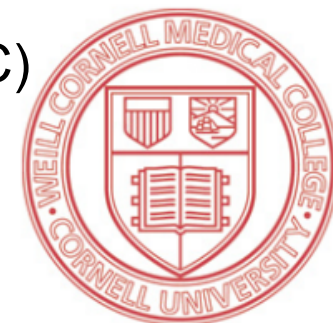

“Safe Zone” is a program designed to increase the overall campus community’s understanding of and capacity to address issues faced by Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender (LGBT) persons.
