The five daily prayers can be said in the chapel every day at the normal prayer times, or in your room. A prayer time schedule, prayer rugs, and Holy Qur'ans are in the chapel. You can also request these items from Spiritual Care Services.

At sundown during the month of Ramadan, dates, water, and fruits are available in the chapel for breaking fast.

Eid prayers are also held in the chapel at the appropriate times.
