Remove the dressing and clean the wound with sterile saline solution. Pat the wound dry with sterile gauze. Apply a thin layer of Vaseline petroleum jelly to the wound. Cover the wound with a sterile dressing. Secure the dressing with sterile tape.

- Apply a sterile dressing to the wound. Secure the dressing with sterile tape. If the dressing becomes wet or soiled, change it immediately. Do not use adhesive tape directly on the wound. Use Band-Aid® adhesive tape around the edges of the dressing.

- If the wound is deep or bleeding, apply direct pressure to the wound with a sterile dressing. If the bleeding does not stop, apply a sterile dressing and secure it with sterile tape. - If the wound is a burn, cool the burn with sterile saline solution. Pat the burn dry with sterile gauze. Apply a thin layer of Vaseline petroleum jelly to the burn. Cover the burn with a sterile dressing. Secure the dressing with sterile tape.
