In his research, Dr. Kircher is developing novel nanoprobe for molecular imaging, image-guided therapy, and theranostics. His laboratory's goal is to develop a technology that can be used to determine the total tumor burden in a patient before, during, and after treatment. This includes potentially being able to precisely detect tumors during neurosurgery for [glioblastoma](#) .
