I have particular interests in cancer-related disorders of hemostasis, clonal hematopoiesis, genomics and machine learning. My recent research work includes an assessment of how cancer-specific genetic alterations affect the risk of thromboembolism, and application of this knowledge to predict clinical events using a statistical model. I also teach medical students, residents, and fellows.


