## How To Set Up Your Blood Pressure Monitor at Home

This information explains how to install blood pressure monitors as part of your care at MSK. They are the Withings BPM Connect, OMRON Silver BP5250, OMRON 5 Series BP7250, and the iHealth Track.

The blood pressure measurements you take at home will help your care team make decisions about your care. They can help them diagnose high blood pressure. They also can use your home blood pressure measurements to adjust your blood pressure medications, if needed.

## How to install the Withings Health Mate app




Figure 1. The Withings Health Mate app

You must download the Withings Health Mate app from the iOS or Google Play Store (see Figure 1).




Figure 2. The notification preference screen

1. Open the Health Mate app on your smartphone or tablet. You will see a notification pop-up (see Figure 2). Select your notification preference.




Figure 3. The sign up and log in screen

2. Sign up for an account (see Figure 3). Tap the "Sign up" blue button. If you already have an account, log in.




Figure 4. The product selection screen

3. Create a new account. Tap "No product yet?" (see Figure 4).




Figure 5. The log in screen

4. Go to the bottom of the screen. Tap "Log in with your e-mail" (see Figure 5).




Figure 6. The new account screen

5. Enter your email address. Then create a password. Next, tap the top 2 selections about terms and privacy policies. Tap the "Sign Up" blue button (see Figure 6).




Figure 7. The profile screen

6. Create your profile. Enter your first name, last name, sex, and date of birth. Tap "Next" (see Figure 7).




Figure 8. The profile screen

7. Continue to create your profile. Enter your height and weight. Tap "Next" (see Figure 8).




Figure 9. Activate Apple Health screen

8. You will see a screen that asks you about activating Apple Health. Tap "Not now" on the left (see Figure 9).




Figure 10. Account activation screen

9. Tap the "Done" blue button (see Figure 10). You have activated your Health Mate account.




Figure 11. Health Mate home screen

10. You can now connect the BPM Connect monitor to your Health Mate account. From the menu at the bottom of the Home screen, tap "Devices" (see Figure 11).




Figure 12. Install a device screen

11. Tap the "Install a device" blue button (see Figure 12).




Figure 13. Product selection screen

12. Tap "Blood pressure monitors" (see Figure 13).




Figure 14. BPM Connect screen

13. Tap "BPM Connect" (see Figure 14).

14. Tap the "Install" blue button (see Figure 15).

15. Get your BPM Connect monitor. Place it near the smartphone or tablet that has the Health Mate app and your MyMSK app. Press and hold the monitor's power button for 3 seconds. Your BPM Connect monitor will display "SETUP." When it is powered on, tap the "Next" blue button (see Figure 16).

16. You will see a blue light and "Setup" on your BPM Connect monitor. The Health Mate app will start to connect to the monitor (see Figure 17).

17. When it connects to your monitor, the Health Mate screen will display "BPM Connect detected." Tap the "Next" blue button (see Figure 18).

18. When you see the prompt, tap the "Pair" blue button to pair the BPM Connect monitor to your smartphone or tablet (see Figure 19).

19. When the Health Mate app has paired with your BPM Connect monitor, tap the "Next" blue button (see Figure 20).




Figure 21. Wi-Fi networks

20. Connect to a Wi-Fi network. You must connect to Wi-Fi to send your blood pressure measurements to your care team. Go to the Wi-Fi selection screen (see Figure 21). Select a network and enter your password. You will see a screen that tells you your BPM Connect monitor is ready (see Figure 22).

## **Connecting your account to MyMSK**




Figure 23. MyMSK mobile app Log in screen

1. Open the MyMSK mobile app and log in (Figure 23).




Figure 24. The emergency notification screen

2. Read the emergency notification. Press the "x" at the top right to close the screen (see Figure 24).




Figure 25. The menu at the bottom shows Messages

3. At the bottom of the screen, select "Messages" (see Figure 25).




Figure 26. The device connection screen

4. Select the message "MSK Device Connection" (see Figure 26).




Figure 27. Screen with link

5. Select the link for Withings account (Figure 27).




Figure 28. The login screen for Validic




Figure 29. The permission screen for Validic

6. Log in to your account (see Figure 28). Select "Allow this app" to connect to Validic (see Figure 29). Your blood pressure measurements will be sent to your MSK care team through Validic.




Figure 30. The final screen for connecting your accounts

7. The accounts will connect. Then select "Done" at the top left corner of the screen (see Figure 30). Your Withings account is now connected to MyMSK.

## How to install the OMRON Silver BP5250




Figure 1. Google Play Store

1. Download the OMRON Connect app from the iOS or Google Play store (see Figure 1).




Figure 2. Connect to Bluetooth

2. Open the app and select "OK" when prompted to connect to Bluetooth (see Figure 2).




Figure 3. Select "United States"

3. Select "United States" (see Figure 3).




Figure 5. Sign up

4. Sign into your OMRON account or sign up if you do not have one (see Figures 4 and 5).






Figure 9. Select "Allow While Using App"




Figure 10. Device pairing to your phone

9. The device will begin pairing your phone (see Figure 10).




Figure 14. MyMSK mobile app Log in screen




Figure 15. The emergency notification screen

2. Read the emergency notification. Press the "x" at the top right to close the screen (see Figure 15).




Figure 16. The menu at the bottom shows Messages

3. At the bottom of the screen, select "Messages" (see Figure 16).




Figure 17. The device connection screen

4. Select the message "MSK Device Connection" (see Figure 17).






Figure 18. Screen with link




Figure 21. The final screen for connecting your accounts

## **How to install the OMRON 5 Series BP7250**




Figure 1. The iOS App Store

1. Download the OMRON Connect app from the iOS or Google Play store (see Figure 1).




Figure 2. Select "OK"

2. Open the app and select "OK" when prompted to connect to Bluetooth (see Figure 2).




Figure 3. Select "United States"

3. Select "United States" (see Figure 3).




Figure 4. Sign in




Figure 5. Sign up

4. Sign into your OMRON account or sign up if you do not have one (see Figures 4 and 5).




Figure 11. MyMSK mobile app Log in screen




Figure 12. The emergency notification screen

2. Read the emergency notification. Press the "x" at the top right to close the screen (see Figure 12).




Figure 13. The menu at the bottom shows Messages




Figure 14. The device connection screen




Figure 15. Screen with link




Figure 16. The login screen for Validic




Figure 17. The permission screen for Validic




Figure 18. The final screen for connecting your accounts

7. The accounts will connect. Then select "Done" at the top left corner of the screen (see Figure 18). Your OMRON account is now connected to MyMSK.

## How to install the iHealth Track




Figure 1. The iOS App Store

1. Download the iHealth MyVitals app from the iOS or Google Play store (see Figure 1).




Figure 2. Select "OK"

2. Select "OK" (see Figure 2).




Figure 3. Select your sharing preferences

3. Select your preference for sharing iHealth data with Apple Health by choosing "Don't Allow" or "Allow" (see Figure 3). MSK will not be collecting data from Apple Health for this program.




Figure 6. Select "Blood Pressure Monitors"

6. Select "Blood Pressure Monitors" (see Figure 6).




Figure 9. Select your Track model

9. Select your Track model when it appears on the screen (see Figure 9).




Figure 11. Device successfully synced

11. The device has successfully been paired when the "SYNC" button appears on the screen (see Figure 11).




Figure 12. MyMSK mobile app Log in screen

1. Open the MyMSK mobile app and log in (Figure 12).




Figure 13. The emergency notification screen

2. Read the emergency notification. Press the "x" at the top right to close the screen (see Figure 13).




Figure 14. The menu at the bottom shows Messages

3. At the bottom of the screen, select "Messages" (see Figure 14).




Figure 15. The device connection screen

4. Select the message "MSK Device Connection" (see Figure 15).






Figure 16. Screen with link

5. Select the link for iHealth account (Figure 16).




Figure 19. The final screen for connecting your accounts

7. The accounts will connect. Then select "Done" at the top left corner of the screen (see Figure 19). Your iHealth account is now connected to MyMSK.
