Clinical trials and research studies help us develop new treatment plans and therapies. They also let us compare these new treatment plans and therapies to ones that already exist.

In one of your upcoming visits, you'll be scheduled for a consent appointment and will meet with a member of the BMT research team. During this visit, a research nurse or advanced practice provider, such as a nurse practitioner (NP) or physician assistant (PA), will talk with you about any research studies you're eligible to participate in. You'll be given a consent form with detailed information about the study. You'll be able to ask questions and decide if you want to participate.
