Who We Screen

Through this program, we provide low-dose CT screening for people who:

- Are between the ages of 50 and 80.
- Smoke now or used to smoke.
- Have smoked an average of one pack per day for at least 20 years, or the equivalent (for example, two packs a day for 10 years).

Our eligibility criteria follows the latest recommendation for lung cancer screening from the American Cancer Society. At MSK, we work to ensure that we are delivering the lowest CT radiation dose possible while still getting highly accurate scans.

When you call [646-497-9163](tel:646-497-9163) , a Care Advisor will double-check to see if a lung screening is right for you. We will answer any questions you may have and help schedule a telemedicine visit (phone call or video chat). At your appointment, you will meet with a licensed practitioner (a physician, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant), who will confirm your eligibility and answer any remaining questions. You can schedule your in-person low-dose CT scan, which will take less than five minutes, at any of our locations. Learn more about [coming to MSK](#) , including our visitor policy.

We will call you with your test results, typically within one business day, and let you know if any additional steps are recommended.

Once we get your results from your initial low-dose CT scan, we will determine if your follow up will be every 12 months or sooner.
