In some people, pheochromocytomas cause sudden cardiac arrest or stroke. They can also cause a dangerous surge in adrenaline in intense situations, like during surgery or after experiencing a severe injury.

Multiple endocrine neoplasia and von Hippel-Lindau disease are genetic conditions that can increase the risk of developing pheochromocytomas and other tumors. Our <u>Clinical Genetics Service</u> can evaluate you if you have signs of these conditions.
