## What Information Will You Need?

In order for this nomogram to provide an accurate prediction, you must include accurate values for all of the information below.

Tumor size: From 0.001 to 20 cm.

Tumor site: Stomach, colon, rectum, or small intestine.

Mitotic index: Whether the mitotic index (i.e., the number of cells in the mitotic phase of the cell cycle) was listed as greater than or equal to 5 per 50 HPF on the pathology report.

To better understand the results of the nomogram, patients should discuss survival estimates with their doctors.
