During a survivorship follow-up, we may:

perform a physical exam and review your medical history
complete an assessment to detect recurrence of cancer
identify, evaluate, and manage any long-term or late effects of cancer and its treatment (both physical and psychological)
discuss methods to prevent new health problems and make health recommendations related to <u>nutrition</u>, <u>exercise</u>, and <u>quitting tobacco use</u>
recommend appropriate cancer screening or <u>genetic testing</u> for other cancers

In addition to working closely with your treatment team, we can provide a treatment summary and <u>Survivorship Care Plan</u> to you, your primary care doctor, and other medical providers. Your physicians can then incorporate this information into your overall medical plan. After each visit, we will update your other medical providers.

As your need for these follow-up visits decreases, we may recommend that you shift your care to your primary care doctor or gynecologist.


