A multidisciplinary team of specialists contributes to your care. This group include experts in [hematologic oncology](#) , [radiology](#) , [pathology](#) , [bone marrow transplantation](#) , and [pain management](#) .

Our team meets regularly to discuss your care plan. We work together to develop a treatment plan tailored to the stage of the disease. Many specialists participate. This ensures that we consider all possible approaches and that you receive the best combination of treatments.

In addition, MSK has nurses who specialize in caring for people with blood disorders. We have a patient-centered focus and place your needs and preferences first. Our nurses and doctors work together as part of your Disease Management Team. Our nurses administer therapies, monitor your treatment, watch for side effects, and offer emotional support.

Doctors at Memorial Sloan Kettering also lead [clinical trials](#) . Some are studying novel therapies and new ways to diagnose rare blood disorders. Clinical trials give many people access to treatments and diagnostic approaches that are not widely available.
