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of effective post-treatment interventions for improving the long-term adjustment of patients and their families. Current studies are examining the psychological adaptation of cancer survivors, and persons with HIV and their families, depression recognition in lung cancer patients, and shame and stigma in head and neck cancer patients. New psychotropic trials are planned through the Counseling Center to ensure that our cancer patients receive the latest in pharmacological treatments with care to understand the complex drug interactions that are possible with multiple medication treatments.
