pediatric tumors.

Clinical experience in the diagnosis and management of neurological complications of cancer, including paraneoplastic syndromes, immunotherapy-related adverse events, and complications of novel CAR-T cell therapy.

Research opportunities in immunology, and basic and translational science at MSK, in our world-renowned research laboratories - the <u>Human Oncology & Pathogenesis Program (HOPP)</u>, <u>Sloan Kettering Institute (SKI)</u>, and <u>the Tri-Institutional Therapeutics Discovery Institute</u> (a partnership between MSK, Rockefeller University, and Weill Cornell Medical Center).
