time is provided to pursue research opportunities, and fellows are encouraged to participate with faculty in clinical research projects. Additionally, fellows can participate in the Hands-on Clinical fMRI and Diffusion Tractography Course, a three-day ACCME-accredited course given by MSK faculty. Fellows have no overnight call responsibilities, as we are staffed by overnight faculty radiologists.

The Department of Radiology is a fully equipped teaching, research, and clinical facility with long-standing support from federal and private agencies for ongoing research and development. Its exceptional facilities enable the development of advanced cancer imaging methods, and because MSK is a tertiary cancer center, the patient population is very diverse. Our state-of-the-art equipment includes fourteen CT scanners (16- and 64-slice and dual-energy) and twenty-one MRI scanners (ten 3T and eleven 1.5T scanners). The neuroradiology service within the Department of Radiology includes 17 faculty members with subspecialties in head and neck, spine, and brain imaging.

Foreign applicants must obtain ECFMG certification, a clinical visa, and a Limited Permit or a full License to Practice Medicine in New York State prior to the fellowship. MSKCC sponsor H-1B and E-3 visas for this program.

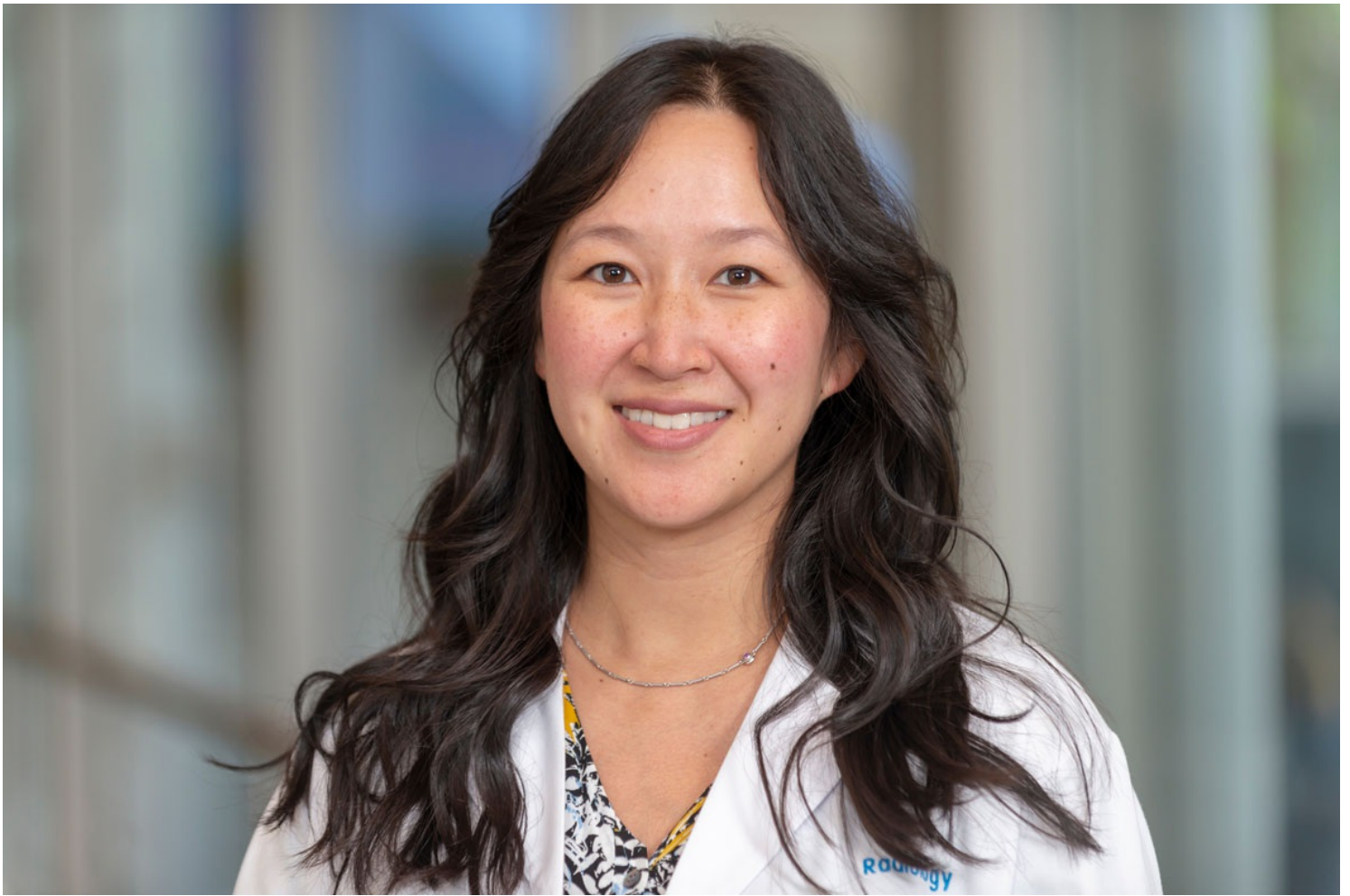
