# **Refund Policy**

Any student who voluntarily leaves the program prior to the first 30 days will receive a full tuition refund minus the initial \$700 nonrefundable acceptance fee. Any student who voluntarily leaves the program after the first 30 days — but within the first three months — will receive 50 percent of his or her tuition back. Any student leaving the program after the first three months will receive no refund. Students who are dismissed from the program during the initial six-month probationary period are not entitled to a refund.
