Currently, the Pharmacy Department has more than 400 employees, with approximately 300 pharmacists serving patients in 26 pharmacy satellites, as well as an annual budget exceeding \$800 million.

The pharmacy department at MSK offers PGY-2 residency programs, one focusing on Adult Oncology, Pediatric Oncology, Medication Use Safety & Quality, and Infectious Diseases allowing the resident to specialize in their specific areas of interest.

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
