Overview of the Rockefeller Outpatient Pavilion

Care Team

At Memorial Sloan Kettering, doctors, nurses, and other specialists work together on treatment teams for each patient. This means that your care team is highly experienced in caring for people with the type of cancer you have. In addition to your medical care, your team will also develop a plan to care for your total well-being, including support for your family and loved ones.

For most cancers, your treatment will be led by one or more primary doctors. These could include a medical oncologist, a surgical oncologist, and a radiation oncologist. Each of these doctors brings a defined set of expertise and techniques for treating cancer.

Visiting the Rockefeller Outpatient Pavilion

The nearest subways stations are: Lexington Avenue/53rd Street (E and M trains) and Lexington Avenue/51st Street (6 train). Transfer is free between the stations.

Notice for E and M train travelers: There will be MTA construction at the 3rd Avenue entrance from October 2022 to June 2023. Use the Lexington Avenue entrance. Expect crowds and allow extra travel time.

Parking Information

Parking for the Rockefeller Outpatient Pavilion is located at Bristol Garage, 300 East 56th Street, between First and Second Avenues.

To receive discounted parking, patients and visitors must have their parking ticket validated at the concierge desk in the Rockefeller Outpatient Pavilion. Shuttle service is provided from Bristol Garage to the Rockefeller Outpatient Pavilion every 20 minutes.


