And we know how important it is to be connected to life outside of MSK Kids, so each room also has a flat-screen TV, gaming devices, and WiFi.

If your child needs close observation, we'll monitor them in the Nicholls-Biondi Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, which is staffed by doctors and nurses who specialize in critical care. A parent or loved one is always welcome at the child's bedside.
