Thompson Hutton, Esq., (Founder, Trustee & CEO of the Geoffrey Beene Foundation) and Harold Varmus, MD. Since its inception, the Geoffrey Beene LLC. and the Geoffrey Beene Foundation have been the sole funding sources. Together, they have funded approximately 120 separate new revolutionary research initiatives across all cancers to develop new treatments for cancer patients.
