Fellows participate in a rich, longitudinal educational curriculum that combines core infectious diseases teaching, critical appraisal of the literature, case-based learning, microbiology, and multidisciplinary conferences. Many sessions bring together fellows and faculty from MSK and Weill Cornell, creating a broader academic community and exposure to diverse clinical perspectives.

Advanced Topics in Infectious Diseases (Grand Rounds)

A joint MSK–Weill Cornell conference featuring faculty and invited speakers who present important clinical advances, emerging research, and contemporary topics across infectious diseases.

Tuesday

8:30–9:30 a.m.

Fellows' Journal Club

A fellow-centered MSK–Weill Cornell conference devoted to critical appraisal of current infectious diseases literature and its application to clinical practice. Early-year sessions also reinforce core concepts and foundational topics.

Wednesday

12:30–1:30 p.m.

ID Clinical Conference

A dynamic case-based forum in which fellows present challenging, unusual, and educational cases from MSK and affiliated training sites, integrating clinical reasoning with focused literature review, microbiology, imaging, and pathology when relevant.

Microbiology Plate Rounds

An interactive experience in the clinical microbiology laboratory highlighting culture plates, diagnostic workflows, organism identification, and practical microbiology pearls drawn from real patient cases.

Fellows may attend MSK Department of Medicine Grand Rounds, which features distinguished speakers and topics spanning contemporary internal medicine, oncology, and related disciplines.
